Time Difference

The USA is divided into six time zones. Eastern Standard Time is GMT -5, and Pacific Standard Time is GMT -8, Alaska is GMT -9, and Hawaii GMT -10. Other than Indiana, Arizona and Hawaii, all states observe daylight saving time in summer.

Opening Hours

Shops are generally open 10h00-21h00 Mon-Fri, 10h00-19h00 Sat-Sun. There are 24-hour stores in almost all large towns and certainly in city districts.

Basic Do's and Don'ts

- ♦ Tipping is expected for most customer services. 15-20% is the norm in restaurants; 10% is reasonable for hotel staff and baggage handlers.
- ♦ Be polite. Good manners will go a long way when dealing with service staff and officials. It may sound obvious, but the words and phrases "Please", "Thank you", "How are you?" and "Have a nice day!" are the currency of happy human transactions in the USA.
- ♦ Bring a credit card with you as it is essential for renting cars, and is often required for other purposes.
- ♦ When attending a sporting event, even if it's kids baseball, often the national anthem will be sung. It is expected that you stand for the duration.
- ♦ The minimum age for consuming alcohol is 21 years. Carry your ID with you if your youthful looks warrant it, as restaurant and bar staff *will* ask for it.
- ♦ Don't shrink away. People are generally less formal than in Europe. First names are often used after initial introductions and physical contact, such as patting the shoulder or arm, is quite normal.
- ♦ Despite the movies a lot of Americans are quite conservative. Consequently it is amazingly easy to inadvertently shock Americans by being too frank in your speech. Cursing is often frowned upon.
- ♦ Don't smoke in public. As a general rule, smoking is prohibited in public places such as restaurants, shops and public transport.

- ♦ Forget the movies: don't buy or use drugs in the USA. Penalties vary according to each state but they are invariably harsh and may involve deportation or imprisonment. As Nancy Reagan advised: "Just say no!"

Climate And Clothing

- ♦ The United States has a broad range of climates, varying from the tropical rain forest and savanna of Hawaii and Florida to the arctic and tundra climates of Alaska.
- ♦ East of the 100th meridian is the humid subtropical climate of the Southeast US and the warm but wet continental climate of Northeast US. Extensive forests are found in both these regions. West of the 100th meridian the grasslands of the Great Plains begin, and the climate is that of a continental interior or "steppes". This is characterized by being dry and warm in summer and extremely cold in winter.
- ♦ The Southwest is covered by large expanses of desert and is the hottest and driest region in the country. Along the Pacific Coast, California experiences a Mediterranean type climate. The Pacific Northwest however is one of the wettest parts of the United States and is densely forested.
- ♦ The Rocky Mountains, Cascades, and Sierra Nevada have typical highland climates.

Safety

- ♦ The water is safe to drink throughout the United States and the standard of all hygiene is extremely high.
- ♦ The United States of America is generally a safe country for visitors to travel in.
- ♦ Theft is not uncommon. Minimize the risk by avoiding leaving items in view inside rental cars and don't carry any valuables visibly while on the streets. For added security, most hotels provide private safes in rooms or have safety deposit boxes for valuables.
- ♦ Ask your hotel concierge for non-recommended areas of the city you are staying in and don't travel alone in unknown areas or at night. Although statistically unlikely, should you be the victim of a mugging it is advised that you hand over your valuables as directed, your assailant may very well be armed and by complying you minimize the risk of harm.
- ♦ International travellers should keep their passport or, ideally, another form of ID with them at all times in case of emergency. Should you be involved in an incident the police will need you to prove your identity.

Shopping

The United States offers boundless consumer possibilities, with every product conceived by human imagination available to buy, frequently at any time of night and for prices that compare favorably with many European countries. New York is rated by some as the shopping capital of the world - where you get exclusive department stores, bohemian market districts, discount art, cult record shops and 24-hour appliance stores. And that's just for starters. The Americans invented the modern shopping mall, and as you might expect, they do it far better than anyone else in the world. For the largest mall in the world, head to Minneapolis, where the massive "Mall of America" welcomes over 42 million visitors per year - in fact, this is officially America's most visited tourist attraction.

What To Buy

- ♦ The USA is the size of a continent and there are few products that universally encompass the experience of the country. European shoppers should look out for sportswear from the famous manufacturers such as Nike, Adidas and Reebok. Often clothes of these labels are far cheaper than across the Atlantic. American street wear names such as Hilfiger, Converse and Vans are also worth looking out for, with the latest designs available in American stores before being taken to Europe. American consumer items are also desirables. Some home products and electrical goods are often available in America before elsewhere. Take care when buying videos or DVDs however as the American versions are only compatible with some systems in Europe and Asia.
